Aligned with Zurich's dedication to sustainability in construction, the selected option for the building's façade is our SGG STADIP PROTECT COOL-LITE SKN 176. This choice is attributed to its advantageous solar control properties. The STADIP PROTECT COOL-LITE SKN 176 incorporates a laminated outer pane, enhancing not only aesthetic appeal but also contributing to improved acoustic performance and safety credentials.

In this project, we collaborated with Dualseal as the glass processor and APiC as the specialist fabricator.


